What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following information to **provide services and goods, including third party referrals:**

- Names and contact details
- Addresses
- Payment details (including card or bank information for transfers and direct debits)

- Website user information (including user journeys and cookie tracking)
- Information relating to compliments or complaints

We collect or use the following information to **receive donations or funding and organise fundraising activities**:

- Names and contact details
- Addresses
- Payment or banking details
- Donation history
- Tax payer information (for Gift Aid purposes)

We collect or use the following personal information for **service updates or marketing purposes**:

- Names and contact details
- Addresses
- Call recordings
- Purchase history
- Donation history
- Website and app user journey information
- Records of consent, where appropriate

We collect or use the following personal information for **research or archiving purposes**:

- Names and contact details

We collect or use the following personal information to **comply with legal requirements**:

How long we keep information

We keep membership data indefinitely subject to a request from you for data to be deleted.

Data from event purchases is kept for 12 months.

We keep gift aid declarations and associated paperwork for up to 6 years after the calendar year to which they relate in order to comply with our legal obligations.
